

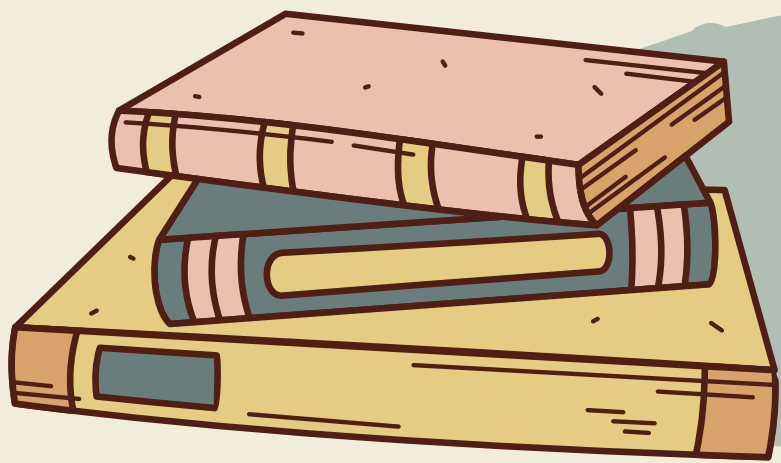
How to choose a good book

Go Random! Grab anything vaguely interesting off the shelves, check it out, and read it! You'll be surprised at what you like.



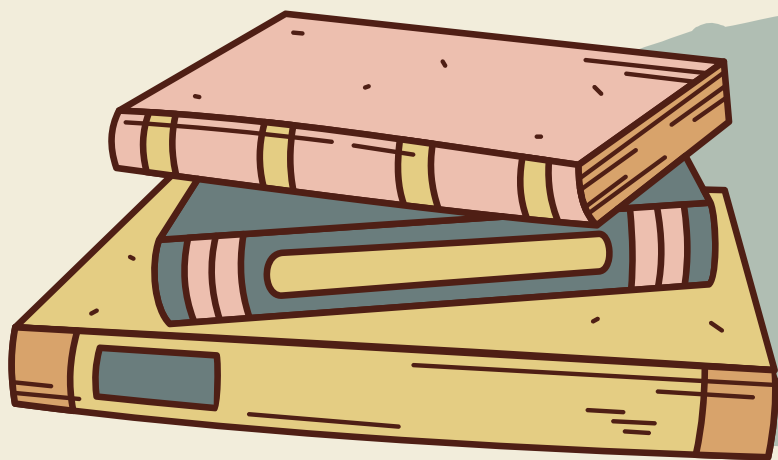
