

## **ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR THE SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME (SAS)?**

### **PARENT/GUARDIAN CONCESSION CARD DETAILS**

A Parent/Guardian may apply for the Secondary Assistance Scheme if he or she holds one of the following cards:

- Services Australia (Centrelink) Pensioner Concession Card;
- Services Australia (Centrelink) Health Care Card; or
- Department of Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card (blue card only, TPI and gold cards cannot be accepted as they are issued for medical benefit purposes only).

#### Cards must meet the following requirements:

- Valid for a period of no less than four weeks.
- Valid sometime within Term 1 (1 February 2021 – 1 April 2021).
- Years 11 and 12 students will possibly not be listed on the parent/guardian concession card. In these circumstances, both the parent/guardian concession card and student concession card must still be produced to prove eligibility.

Applications **must be completed annually in Term 1** (an application does not automatically cover all secondary school years).

The concession card must be valid at the time of SAS application (cannot use an expired concession card to apply for SAS).
