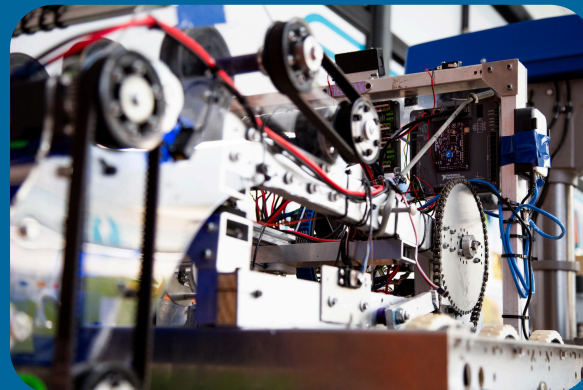

WHY WE ASSESS
